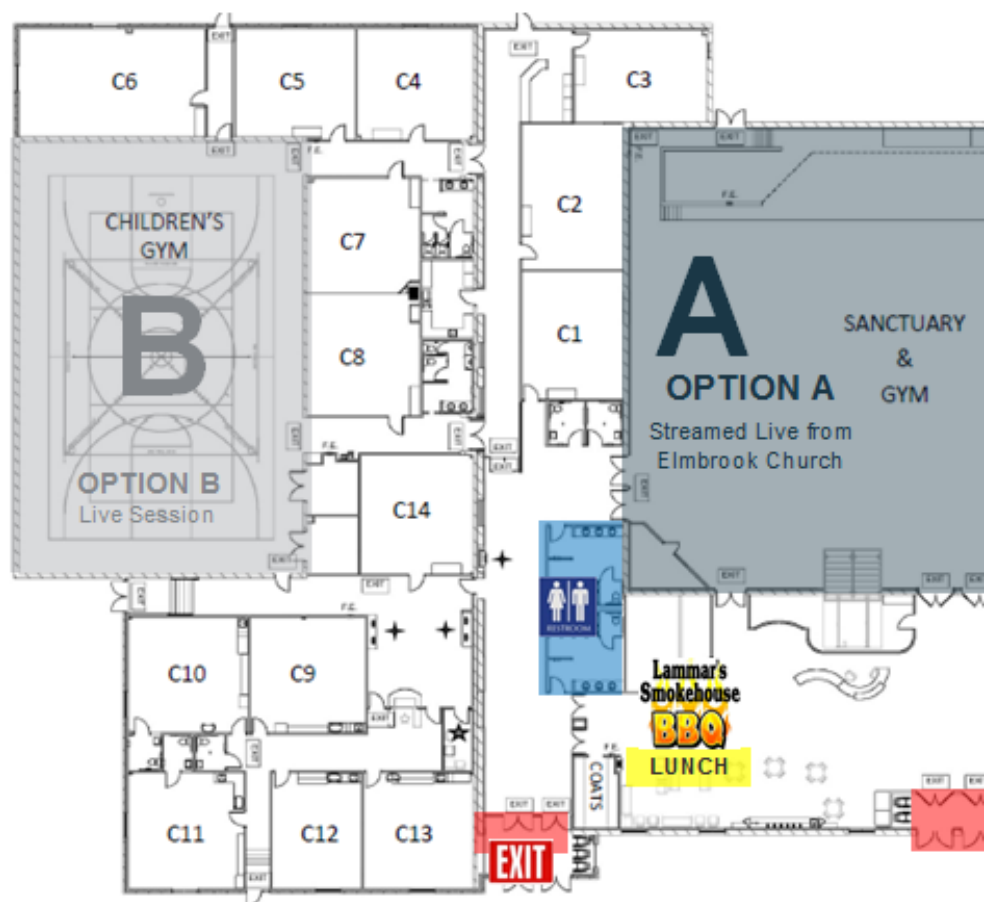

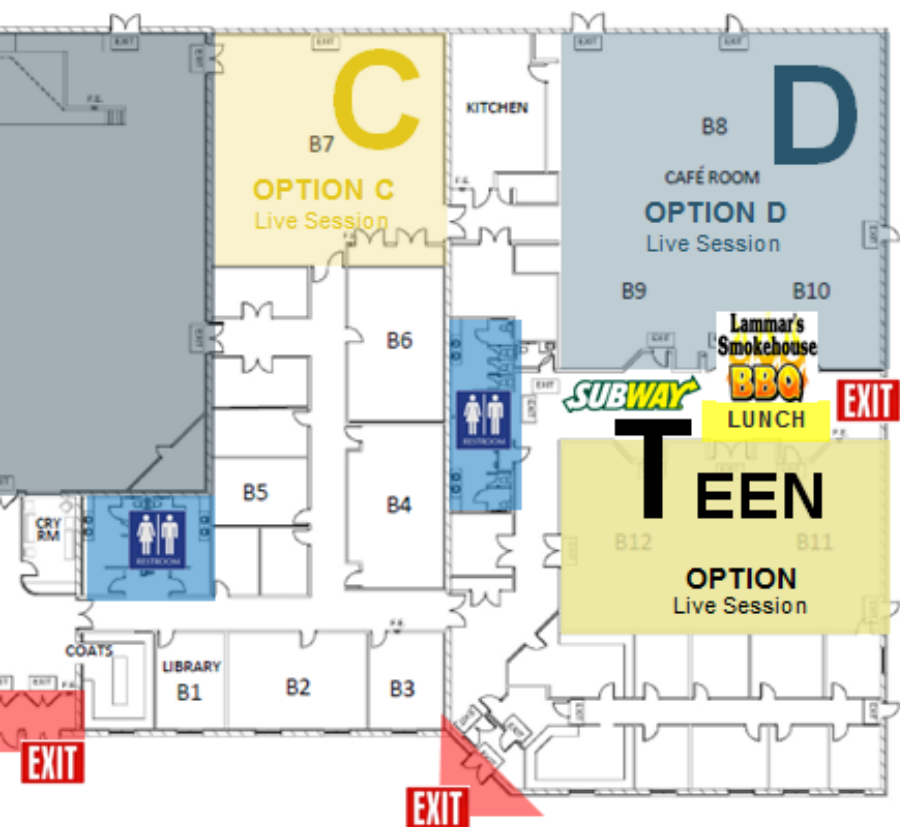

Learning to Suffer Well – with Church & Family at the Same Time"

Eric will share lessons learned from 3 years of church issues due to transitions out of his control but within his responsibility as an Elder and lead pastor. Explore how to handle people who leave or run from your church but don't bother to talk with you. How to address "malicious gossip" (3 John 9) and encourage the faithful who stay committed.

Eric will also share lessons learned from his wife, Chris, and her emergency surgery to remove two growths thought to be cancerous but eventually turned out to be benign.

- Do not walk the journey alone, but reach out for help.
- Die to self - and keep a normal routine.
- Re-adjust for the long road of recovery and a new normal.

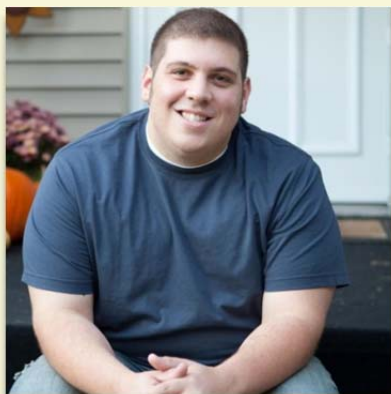
