CONNECT

- What characterizes a person who is living on point (versus a person who lives rather aimlessly)?

GROW

- Read Luke 19:11-27. What concern does Jesus address with His parable (see verse 11)? Based on Jesus' parable, how would you sum up His response to the concern noted in verse 11?
- While we await the return of our King, how are we called to live? Create a list of what faithful living looks like based on the following Scriptures – consider using a whiteboard or something similar – (Psalm 15; 1 Peter 2:13-17; Romans 12:9-21). Which of these areas do you take seriously? Which ones do you need to put more thought and effort into?
- How do each of these Scriptures motivate you to faithful living (Romans 8:1; 1 Corinthians 3:10-15; 2 Corinthians 5:10; Revelation 22:12)?

GO

- What is your next step toward faithful living as you wait for the return of your King?
