



Honoring the Lord with your First Fruits

Scripture tells us to give our first fruits to the Lord—in other words, we give to Him before we commit our resources anywhere else. First Fruits is Highland’s program to help you do that through electronic giving. In the same way that you may choose to pay certain expenses (e.g., mortgage payment, health club membership dues, etc.) by electronic withdrawal you can make contributions to Highland by signing up for electronic withdrawals from your checking or savings account.

Now you can also give toward The Next Generation Capital Campaign (A three year program, starting in 2015, to raise 2.5 million to add onto the Wausau Campus with a secure children's wing, an expanded fellowship area, and the ability to simulcast between our campuses.) by modifying your current First Fruits donation or signing up for this program.

Electronic Withdrawal Basics



Electronic withdrawal allows you to specify an amount to be withdrawn from your checking or savings account on a weekly, semi-monthly, or monthly basis.

The first way to do this is to sign up by filling out the attached form and including a voided check or deposit slip. Mail or drop off this information to the Church Office.

REMEMBER:

- ◆ Electronic withdrawals are regulated by the Federal Reserve and are very safe
- ◆ There is no charge to you for electronic withdrawals
- ◆ You may alter the distribution or amount of your electronic withdrawal at any time by using the attached form, or you may also contact Alison Clements in the church office on Mondays.
- ◆ You must let us know 15 days prior to the next withdrawal date to make your change effective

Another way you can manage your giving electronically is directly through your bank’s on-line bill pay program. Most banks in our area offer this service at no charge to their customers and at no cost to Highland. Contact your bank directly to set up on-line bill pay and set Highland up as a payment.
