What's up with food?

Is there a packing list?

Yes. Here it is: your Bible, sleeping bag, pillow, clothes (especially some that can get dirty and wet and some that keep you warm), a swimsuit (girls, please bring a one-piece), shoes for rafting (flipflops do NOT work on the river – Chacos, water shoes, old tennis shoes work well), bug spray, sun lotion, beach towel, toiletries and towel, a tent if you have one (please let Pastor Jarrod know ASAP if you have one you can bring), snacks if desired (see note above), and your IMPACT binder if you already have one.

When do we leave/pack the trailer?

We will NOT be using our trailer. Feel free to bring everything when we leave on Wednesday, July 25 @ 12pm. We will be returning at 12pm on Friday, July 27.

Can I bring my phone or other electronics?

There will not be electricity on our campsite and limited electricity during our time at Thornton's, so electronics are not encouraged. If you bring your electronic device, you will be responsible for keeping it safe (we will be away from our tents for large periods of time) and you will be encouraged disconnect from technology and connect with the group during our retreat. Pastor Jarrod will have his cell phone for emergencies and for students and parents to connect as needed!
