General Interest—This Month

Revive Wisconsin! Jesus commands His followers to "Go and make disciples" (see Matthew 28:18-20)! This is an amazing and sometimes frightening privilege. Many churches in our area have been gathering to pray for people in our community to come to know Jesus. We have also been praying that God will send forth workers to gather the harvest that is ready to be reaped! Time to Revive Ministries is partnering with Gospel-loving and Gospel-preaching churches in the Greater Wausau area. They desire to train and equip churches to share the Gospel and disciple those who place their trust in Jesus for the forgiveness of their sins.

Highland has been chosen as the host church for Revive Wisconsin. When we partner with area churches, we are choosing to unite around the Gospel. We realize in doing this, that there are things other churches may do that may make us feel uncomfortable. It is even possible that some of the trainers (from Revive Wisconsin) may have slightly different doctrinal distinctives than generally held at Highland. But one hallmark of the Evangelical Free Church is that we desire to major on majors and minor on minors, and for the sake of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, we believe it is right to partner graciously with our brothers and sisters in Christ in this way. Would you consider how you will participate in Revive Wisconsin, especially as we prepare for a week of intentional outreach to our community (August 13-19)?

Here are some ways you can participate:

- Pray for revival to start in Central Wisconsin and to spread throughout our State!
- Repent of known sin (we can be better witnesses to God's transforming power when we ourselves are being transformed!)
- Be willing to be a discipler of brand new believers discipleship material consists mostly of Bible accounts and is very easy to use (you just need to stay one step ahead you are not required to be a Bible-scholar!). Materials and training are

- Be willing to be part of a four person team that goes into the community to pray for people and to share the gospel. We will be thoroughly trained for this. What a great way to step out in faith and to see God's faithfulness firsthand!!
