
At Highland we believe that

Our policies about weddings come from these convictions.

First, a few principles we follow:

- God's plan for marriage is that you be on the same page spiritually in order to build a firm foundation.
- God puts great emphasis on sexual purity before marriage. Couples we marry must honor this important mandate.
- We're interested in your having a good marriage, not just a good wedding. So we require several counseling sessions before your wedding.
- We desire that you plug into the life of the church as a couple.

GETTING MARRIED AT HIGHLAND

Because our objective is to establish Christian marriages in the context of a loving community, weddings are reserved only for individuals who are committed followers of Christ and who are regular attenders of Highland Community Church.

Wedding plans begin by scheduling an appointment. To do that, contact our Administrator, Jolene Fenwick, at jfenwick@highlandcommunitychurch.com to start your planning process. At this first appointment you'll talk about your desires for your wedding, learn about our policies, see the building and look at available dates.

Because Scripture shows that living separately from each other and abstaining from sexual intimacy before marriage are God's design for each couple, we ask that you commit to these principles in respect for God's design, in respect for each other, and in order to get the most benefit from your pre-marriage preparation.



SETTING THE DATE

The earlier you can involve Highland in your planning process, the more likely we will be able to find a date that works for you and for Highland. Please bring your options for wedding dates with you to your appointment with Jolene. We will do all we can to work with staff and facility commitments to try to accommodate your plans.

CHOOSING A HIGHLAND PASTOR

You may already have in mind the pastor you want to perform your ceremony. We will do all we can to honor your request.

CHOOSING A HIGHLAND CAMPUS

We have three campus locations: Marathon, Wausau, and Weston to consider for your wedding.

PARTICIPATING IN PRE-MARITAL COUNSELING

We require couples to participate in 6 hours of pre-marital counseling that explore key issues of marriage including: understanding each other, spirituality, conflict resolution, finances, sexuality and others.

GIVING CONSIDERATION

It is customary for the bride and groom to give the officiating pastor an honorarium for the services he provides both in pre-marital counseling and in helping to prepare the marriage ceremony and message. We'll discuss other possible fees and honoraria during the course of planning your wedding.

HAVING AN OUT OF TOWN WEDDING?

In certain circumstances, it may be possible for a Highland Pastor to perform a marriage someplace other than Highland. In those instances, please cover his additional expenses including lodging and meals.

WANTING TO RENT THE FACILITY & USE AN OUTSIDE PASTOR?

We are not able to accommodate weddings for those outside the Highland Church body and/or to rent the facility for weddings using only an outside pastor due to facility and schedule constraints.
